



Per-Diem Shelter Veterinarian

Idaho Humane Society is seeking a full time veterinarian for our Shelter Medicine Program. The Idaho Humane Society is an open-admission animal shelter located in beautiful Boise. We serve about 12,000 animals annually including strays, owner surrenders, transfers from rural Idaho and transfers from out of state. Our shelter also supports a range of other programs including public-supported TNR and partnerships with nearby reservations. Our community support allows us to practice a high standard of shelter medicine including a wide range of soft tissue and orthopedic surgeries, in-house digital radiography, a dental suite and new dental radiology unit, in-house lab work, and more. Our Shelter Medicine Program also supports a veterinary student rotation with Washington State University. Two to three veterinary students rotate with us for 2 weeks, focusing on spay/neuter surgery and shelter medicine exams.

A successful candidate will have either experience in shelter medicine or a strong interest and drive to learn. They should be confident in soft tissue surgical skills, especially spay/neuter. A per-diem shelter veterinarian must be capable of performing 20 spays/neuters on a mixture of dogs and cats in a 5 hour surgery window. Interest in dentistry is a plus. After surgery. The per-diem shelter veterinarian will assist in physical exams of shelter patients or foster animals as needed.

- Position is per-diem. Preference will be given to candidates who can offer a regular set schedule of 2-4 days per month. Shifts are 8-10 hours, depending on workload.
- Compensation: \$50.00/hour
- Education: Must possess a Doctorate of Veterinary Medicine
- Requirements: Currently licensed in Idaho to practice veterinary medicine or ability to obtain license upon hire
